Handling of information

An applicant's name, address and other personal information submitted to Keio Academy of New York at the time of application will be used only for admission purposes and, if accepted, for matriculation into Keio Academy of New York.
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Successful applicant will be admitted to Keio Academy of New York as a 9th or 10th graders with following scholarship:

- **The first year of entrance examination fee, admissions fee and full tuition will be waived.**
- **If the students' grade and behavior remains satisfactory, he/she may apply for a half tuition waiver for the second year.**
- **After the second year, the student may apply to our regular scholarship program.
(Half tuition and/or half room and board)**

Biography of George Aratani

Mr. George Aratani is a Japanese-American industrialist. He was born on May 22, 1917 in Gardena, California to Japanese parents. After completing high school, he attended Keio University in Japan. Later, he enrolled at Stanford University. However, acting upon a recommendation by an executive staff member at his father's company, he left Stanford and joined the family business.

In 1943, after his family business closed, he taught Japanese language at the Military Intelligence School at Camp Savage, in Minnesota. In 1950, using his extensive knowledge of Japanese language and culture, he founded the Mikasa company in California. Three years later, he started Amco K.K. in Japan. Then in 1961, he established Kenwood, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Mikasa Corporation in the United States.

Currently, Mr. Aratani serves as a Member of the Board of Trustees and Senior Advisor to the National Japanese American Memorial Foundation and the Japanese-American Cultural and Community Center. He established the Aratani Foundation and continues to contribute to the development of Japanese culture.

On April 1, 2008, Mr Aratani was awarded the Order of the Rising Sun, Gold and Silver Star by the Japanese government, in recognition of his work to advance the social-welfare of Japanese-American citizens, to preserve and pass on a Japanese cultural heritage, and to promote friendship between the United States and Japan.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLYING

Students may apply for admission into the 9th or 10th grade of Keio Academy of New York under this scholarship program if they meet the following criteria:

(1) An applicant for the 9th grade must be enrolled in the 8th grade of education in the United States of America; expecting to have completed his/her 8th grade by August 31 of the year he/she wishes to enter the School. The applicant must be a US citizen with Japanese ancestry, and at least one of the legal guardians must be a US citizen. The applicant must be a well-rounded student who is both academically strong and accomplished in non-academic areas. The applicant must also possess a keen interest in learning Japanese heritage, language and culture.

(2) An applicant for the 10th grade must be enrolled in the 9th or 10th grade of education in the United States of America; expecting to have completed his/her 9th or 10th grade by August 31 of the year he/she wishes to enter the School. The applicant must be a US citizen with Japanese ancestry, and at least one of the legal guardians must be a US citizen. The applicant must be a well-rounded student who is both academically strong and accomplished in non-academic areas. The applicant must also possess a keen interest in learning Japanese heritage, language and culture.

APPLICATION PERIOD

Applications will be accepted starting Tuesday, September 1, 2009

For the first selection, application must be received by Wednesday, September 30, 2009

For the second selection, application must be received by Friday, January 22nd, 2010

For the third selection, application must be received by Friday, April 16th, 2010

PLEASE NOTE:

An applicant has to choose one of the three application opportunities above.

An applicant is not entitled to apply for Aratani scholarship after he/she receives the acceptance through

AO Fall or Regular examination.

No action will be taken on your application until all of the necessary items have been received by mail. If materials are missing, a notice will be sent identifying the missing item(s). Missing item(s) must be received no later than the due date. Once submitted, no part of the application material can be returned. Please make sure to send the application materials to the School by either courier (e.g. FedEx or DHL) or via express mail. Please do not use regular mail as the receipt cannot be confirmed. Also, please do not use registered mail as this will significantly delay the delivery.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Application for Admission

The applicant or a parent must complete this form in English. Please use the applicant's legal name (no nickname). Fill out the email address clearly and legibly. Please fill out the country code for your phone and fax number. Please do not forget a zip code. Typing is acceptable.

English Essay

Please choose one of the following. Essay must be 400 to 600 words in length and must be typed.

You must write in English. In addition we prefer that the applicant submit their own Japanese translation of the essay.

- Write a well-organized essay in which you discuss your special talents and qualifications that are truly your own. How will you contribute positively to the culture and ambience of Keio Academy of New York?
- Write a well structured essay of at least three paragraphs explaining in detail how you will make the graduating class of 2012 (or 2013) a better class.

Official Transcripts

The applicant's school(s) must send official transcripts for all grades beginning with the 7th grade and including the current grade.

Recommendations All applicants must submit both forms ① and ②. Preferably forms ① and ② should be filled out by different referees.

① Academic Recommendation (We do not accept a recommendation from a weekend school):

This form must be completed by a teacher who has known the student. If an academic recommendation from the designated official cannot be obtained, please contact the Admissions Office at Keio Academy of New York. The envelope must be sealed by a school official.

② Character Recommendation: This form must be completed by an adult who knows the applicant well. A recommendation from a family member is not acceptable. The envelope must be sealed by the referee.

Other material (Optional)

To strengthen your application, you may provide extensive details of both academic and non-academic accomplishments as well as your personal history in relation to Japanese language or Japanese culture. If you have any, please attach evidence of language ability. Nothing you submit will be returned.
